



Custer County Foundation 2020 Fall Grant Recipients

The Foundation awarded \$39,100 to 10 Custer County organizations this Fall. Following is a list of organizations selected to receive a grant:

4 County Kids, \$3,000: Supplies for a Children's take-home fair bag.

Broken Bow Aquatic Center, \$1,500: To help purchase an AED Healthcare Package and AED Trainer.

Broken Bow Backpack Program, \$5,000: To provide food vouchers for school-aged children and their families.

Broken Bow Lead4Change, \$1,400: To help with a student-led cafeteria extension project.

Broken Bow MS/HS STEM Lab, \$3,000: To help purchase equipment to allow students to build a computer for the STEM lab.

Callaway Good Life Center, \$2,200: To help purchase a medication cart.

The Comstock Den, \$3,500: To help with repairing the building foundation.

Custer County Sheriff's Office, \$2,500: To help with costs associated with getting a Patrol Service Dog.

Diamond Youth Organization/Broken Bow American Legion Baseball, \$15,000: To help purchase a scoreboard for Paul Brown field.

Village of Mason City, \$2,000: To help restore buildings that were damaged in the March 2019 flood.

In addition to the grants listed above, the Foundation also awarded \$20,000 to seven non-profit organization to assist with COVID relief efforts. The organizations receiving assistance were: Broken Bow Backpack Program, Broken Bow Ministerial Association, Callaway Good Life Center, Central Plains Center for Services, Diaper Depot, Healing Hearts & Families, and Spartan Foundation.
