The Foundation awarded \$31,900 to 14 Custer County organizations! Following is a list of organizations selected to receive a grant.

Ansley Village Teacher's Organization: \$500 to help with the 2016 end of year color fun run.

Arnold Rotary Club: \$2,000 for a covered shelter at the Arnold State Recreation Area.

Arnold School House Graphics: \$1,500 to purchase a Vectric Aspire 3-D design software for CNC manufacturing, two compatible computers to operate the specialized software with, and the necessary bits for the CNC router.
