

Custer County Foundation Fall 2014 Grant Recipients

The Foundation awarded \$37,355 to 17 Custer County organizations! Following is a list of organizations selected to receive a grant.

Ansley-Litchfield DYO: \$3,000 to provide the Ansley-Litchfield Spartan baseball and softball teams with a second practice field.

Ansley Public Schools: \$1,250 to provide a sand volleyball court to be used by students as well as the public during non-school hours.

Ansley Village Teachers Organization: \$605 to assist with the costs associated with their end of year school color fun run.

Arnold Community Theatre/Rialto: \$2,000 to provide new seating to replace outdated seating.

Broken Bow Activities Department: \$2,000 to assist in purchasing a new wrestling mat. **Broken Bow Elks Lodge** #1688: \$1,000 to help pay for a Thank You dinner for Custer County Veterans.

Broken Bow Lions Club: \$5,000 to help with building a home for the Helping Hands House and The Broken Bow Food Pantry.

Callaway Housing Corporation: \$2,750 to install insulation to make energy saving improvements at Grand Generation Manor.

Custer Care: \$2,500 for hearing devices at the movie theater for the hearing impaired.
